If you need additional assistance, please feel free to ask any Team Member. The Park Guide Map is available inside the Park turnstiles and includes a layout of the Park. The day's show schedule also is available.

To maintain the Park's family atmosphere, we ask that all Guests be courteous to other visitors and Team Member. Please abide by all safety information posted throughout the Park or provided by our Team Members.

Tickets

At the Front Gate, you will find clearly marked disability accessible windows for purchasing admission tickets and Season Passes. Regular admission ticket and Season Pass prices apply. (Prices are subject to change without notice.)

Guest Services

Guest Services is located to the left of the turnstiles and provides a variety of services including this brochure in large print, showtimes, and information about Park amenities and services.

Accessibility

Most of Wild Adventures is accessible to our Guests with disabilities. All disability entrances and exits are clearly marked at rides and

attractions. Please ask any Team Member if you need assistance or have any questions.

First Aid

Wild Adventures staffs two First Aid Offices—one in the Dockside area; one in Splash Island near the restrooms; First Aid is staffed with certified EMTs and paramedics. If you should have a medical emergency, please contact the nearest Team Member who will notify First Aid to respond. Guests bringing medications that must be refrigerated and/or extra oxygen bottles may leave these items in any First Aid Office. Please clearly label medications and other personal belongings with the responsible party's name, address, phone number and the date. ID is required to retrieve items.

Wheelchair & ECV Rental

Wheelchairs and Electric Convenience Vehicles (ECVs) are available daily for rent on a first-come, first-served basis. Wheelchairs are \$7 per day. ECVs are \$32 per day. A security deposit is required. Operator training is required for ECVs. Prices are subject to change without notice. Wheelchairs and ECVs may be rented and returned at Stroller & Wheelchair Rental located outside the turnstiles.

Please note: All Guests using wheelchairs and ECVs, whether personal or rented at Wild Adventures, must follow all manufacturer's operating guidelines and Park rules. Park rules are available at the rental booth for Guests bringing their own wheelchairs or ECVs. Wild Adventures also reserves the right to deny entry to any ECV or wheelchair deemed unsafe for use on Park near other Guests. Only one Guest per ECV or wheelchair. No passenger carriers and/or trailers of any type may be attached to ECVs. Guests must be 16 or older to rent an ECV in the Park. The Guest using the ECV must rent the ECV.

If walking or standing present physical challenges, we strongly recommend the use of a wheelchair or ECV to navigate Wild Adventures. Please remember that the distance between various Park buildings and attractions is much greater than any wait in line.

General Information

Companion-Assisted Restrooms

For our Guests' convenience, we offer disability accessible, Companion-Assisted Restrooms in the following location:

Companion Assistance

Due to the nature and layout of our Park, Wild Adventures recommends that anyone legally blind or who has vision impairments enjoy the Park with a companion. Please ask any Team Member if you have further questions.

Service Animals

Service animals are welcome in most locations throughout Wild Adventures. Animals must be in the owner's control and under control at all times. Service animals must be on a harness or leash no longer than four feet. Owners are responsible for cleaning and disposing of any animal waste.

Service animals are not allowed on rides or attractions with the exception of the Safari Train. If you wish to ride, we suggest a companion visit the Park with you to care for your service animal. Service animals must not be left unattended or with Team Members.

Due to the Amazing Cats & Creature Features show content, we ask that any service animal remain under the owner's feet as to not distract the tigers and other animals for the safety of our staff. Wild Adventures reserves the right to deny access to a service animal when safety is in question.

Theaters

For the convenience of Guests using wheelchairs or ECVs, early entry is available before doors open for general seating. Doors open at least 15 minutes prior to showtimes in the Adventure Playhouse, Amazing Cats, and SHAZZAM Theaters. The theater is equipped to provide one (1) companion seat at every wheelchair/ECV space. Due to the layout and capacity of each theater, larger groups accompanying a Guest in a wheelchair or ECV may have to separate. Ushers are available to assist with wheelchair/ECV parking and seating. For additional assistance, please contact any Theater Usher or Team Member.

General Information

Due to Georgia State Fire Codes, Guests using ECVs or wheelchairs may not park in any theater aisle or row. Seating is limited in all theaters and is filled on a first-come, first-served basis.

All outdoor theaters are accessible to Guests with disabilities. All safety guidelines and fire codes for indoor theaters also apply to outdoor venues. If you have any questions, please notify a sound technician in the back of the theater or any other Team Member.

Show Scripts: Wild Adventures regular season show scripts are available for use during the show and must be returned at the end of the performance. Please see a Theater Usher for assistance. Scripts are also available on the Safari Train.

Smoking

Smoking at Wild Adventures is permitted only in designated smoking areas.

Shops & Restaurants

Wild Adventures shops and restaurants are accessible to Guests with disabilities. Please ask any Team Member if you need assistance reaching items or have special dietary needs.

Complimentary Ice Water

Most Wild Adventures food/concession locations that serve fountain drinks also offer complimentary cups of ice water.

Ride Guidelines & Rules

Amusements & Games

All amusements and games are accessible to Guests with disabilities. All amusements and games require an additional fee and are not included in Park admission.

Medical Restrictions

All Ride Safety Information is posted at each ride entrance so that you may make informed decisions on your ability to safely participate. This brochure describes the ride's movements and forces while the ride safety signs include medical restrictions and special safety instructions.


Remember: Wild Adventures does not know your medical history or restrictions. Please review all safety information prior to boarding. Please be aware of all medical and height restrictions. We also encourage you to watch the ride or attraction prior to choosing to ride. If in doubt, do not ride.

Food & Drink

You may finish food and drinks while waiting in line. However, eating, drinking or chewing gum or candy while riding is prohibited with the exception of the Safair Train.

Securing Loose Items

Glass items, game prizes, umbrellas, canes, crutches, caps, glasses, cameras and other loose items must be left with a non-riding member of your party or stored in a Park rental locker or your personal vehicle. Some rides provide shelves or bins to store these items while riding; however, Wild Adventures is not responsible for items damaged, lost or stolen during your ride experience.

Remember: Ride Team Members are assigned and in place to ensure Guest safety and to operate the ride. Thus, they cannot be responsible for Guests' personal items. Park rental lockers are available for rent, and locations are indicated on the Park Guide Map by this symbol: 

Boarding a Ride or Attraction

Guests using wheelchairs or ECVs or those with other disabilities may use the marked disability entrances to gain access to the ride

or attraction. These entrances are designed to provide access to the ride, not to expedite your wait. You may have to wait once reaching the loading area. If you need assistance transferring from your ECV or wheelchair, you must visit the Park with a companion. Our ride Team Members may provide information or answer questions; however, they are not trained to assist you in transferring to and from a ride vehicle and will not be able to do so.

Restraint Systems

Guests must fit properly into all ride restraint systems to participate. All rides and attractions at Wild Adventures are designed for persons with average body stature and proportion. Some ride restraint systems may not accommodate Guests of larger weight and/or greater height.

For the safety of Guests nearby, those wearing casts, braces or prostheses may be unable to ride due to the inability to be properly restrained.

Oxygen Tanks

Due to the forces, speeds and movements of our rides, oxygen tanks are not permitted on ride vehicles or boats. Oxygen tanks are allowed on the Safari Train and trams.

Artificial Limbs & Amputees

On some rides, Guests who are amputees or those with artificial limbs may be unable to participate due to the inability to remain properly restrained during the ride or attraction. Guests must securely lock or remove any prostheses before boarding to ensure the safety of other Guests.

Ride Evacuations

Evacuations may be required in the unlikely event of mechanical difficulties or inclement weather. In the event of an evacuation, Guests may need to maneuver across catwalks and/or descend steep steps. Those unable to evacuate may need to wait, restrained in their seats, for further assistance to arrive.

Symbols



This symbol indicates that Guests can remain in their wheelchairs or ECVs throughout the ride or attraction. It also identifies disability entrances throughout the Park.



This symbol indicates that Guests who use wheelchairs or ECVs must transfer from their vehicle to a ride vehicle to ride.



This symbol indicates that Guests using ECVs must transfer from their ECV to a wheelchair to participate in the attraction.



This symbol indicates that Guests who use wheelchairs or ECVs must be able to leave their vehicles and walk or be assisted by their companion to the ride entrance.



This symbol indicates that Guests must meet a minimum height requirement to ride.



This symbol indicates a High Thrill Attraction featuring high speeds with extremely unusual and stressful physical forces. This ride contains startling and unexpected thrills appropriate for only the most healthy and physically able riders.



This symbol indicates a Moderate Thrill Attraction featuring moderate speeds with unexpected movements and unusual and stressful physical forces including but not limited to unanticipated thrills.



This symbol indicates a Mild Thrill Attraction featuring low speeds with expected movements and anticipated thrills.

Adventure Quest Raceway

Minimum Height:

Single-58" or taller

Double-58" taller to drive

Junior-42" or taller

Passenger-36" or taller

Age Requirement:

Single-10 years of age or older

Double-18 years of age or older (WITH VALID I.D.)

Junior-7 years of age or older

Passenger-4 years of age or older

Ride Time: 5 min



Fun filled driving experience that allows guests to drive at safe speeds around a curvy track. All guests are required to meet minimum height and admissions requirements, regardless of ability. Each ride unit is equipped with a 4 point restraint seatbelt harness. Due to operating systems, all guests are required to use all restraint systems on the ride. Those restraints must be able to be positioned properly. Guests wearing casts or other restrictive devices may not be able to ride if it prohibits proper securing of the restraint device. The access entrance for Adventure Quest Raceway is at the exit area. Guests must leave wheelchair, carts, etc. to load the ride. These devices may be left on the inside of the gated exit area. Ride personnel do not have the training required to physically load or unload Guests who need assistance. Guests needing assistance transferring from ECVs or wheelchairs must visit the Park with a companion. Our ride Team Members may provide information or answer questions. Only companions necessary to assist during the ride cycle should enter with the disabled guest-maximum of one (1) guest and companion. This is based on the number of seats per unit (1-2). All other riders should enter the ride as other guests through the entrance. The disabled guest and their companion should be placed on the next available vehicle. Service animals only are permitted to accompany guests while in the queue line. The service animal may not enter ride vehicles.

Ant Farm Express

Minimum Height: 36" Guests between 36" and 44" must ride with someone 16 years of age or older.

Ride Time: 45 sec

With speed ranging from 11-30 mph, this small coaster gives younger

Guests the feel of a thrill ride. The ride is secure with lap bar restraints. Due to operating systems, all guests are required to use all restraint systems on the ride. Those restraints must be able to be positioned properly. All Guests wearing casts or other restrictive devices may not be able to ride if it prohibits proper securing of the restraint device. The access entrance for Ant farm Express is at the exit gate. Guests may leave wheelchairs, carts, etc. . . near exit gate on the platform. Ride personnel do not have the training required to physically load or unload Guests who need assistance. Guests needing assistance transferring from ECVs or wheelchairs must visit the Park with a companion. Our ride Team Members may provide information or answer questions. Only companions necessary to assist during the ride cycle should enter with the disabled Guest- maximum of (1) Guest due to the maximum number of riders per unit (2) for this ride. All other riders should enter at the entrance of the attraction. The disabled Guest and their companion should be placed on the next available ride vehicle. Please keep hands and feet inside at all times and remain seated. Do not attempt to exit the ride until it has come to a complete stop and an attendant has told you it is safe to exit. Service animals are only permitted to accompany Guests while in the queue line. The service animal may not enter ride vehicles.

Aviator



Minimum Height: 42" Anyone between 42"- 48" must be accompanied by someone 16 years of age or older.

Ride Time: 3 minutes 25 sec

With heights topping out at a 100 feet, guests can expect to spin 8.6 rpm in a circular motion. Each ride is equipped with Shoulder Harness Restraints with a Restraint Belt Strap that attaches to the harness. All Guests are required to use all restraint systems on the ride. Those restraints must be able to be positioned properly. All Guests wearing casts or other restrictive devices may not be able to ride if it prohibits proper securing of the restraint device. The access entrance for Aviator is at the exit gate. . Guests may leave wheelchairs, carts, etc. . . near exit gate on the platform. Ride personnel do not have the training required to physically load or unload Guests who need assistance. Guests needing assistance transferring from ECVs or wheelchairs must visit the Park with a companion. Our ride Team Members may provide information or answer questions. Only companions necessary to assist during the ride cycle should enter with the disabled Guest- maximum of (1) Guest due to

the maximum number of riders per unit (2) for this ride. All other riders should enter at the entrance of the attraction. The disabled Guest and their companion should be placed on the next available ride vehicle. Do not attempt to exit the ride until it has come to a complete stop and an attendant has told you it is safe to exit. Service animals are only permitted to accompany Guests while in the queue line. The service animal may not enter ride vehicles.

Bee Bop



Minimum Height: Under 36" must ride with someone 16 years of age or older

Ride Time: 1 min 30 sec

Guests ride in rotating, bouncing "bee" vehicles on this children's rotating flying ride. Guests must have upper body control and be able to sit up straight with the Safety Belt Restraints fastened. Please keep seat belts buckled at all times. Please keep hands and feet inside at all times and remain seated. All Guests wearing casts or other restrictive devices may not be able to ride if it prohibits proper securing of the restraint device. The access entrance for Bee Bop is at the exit gate. . Guests may leave wheelchairs, carts, etc. . . near exit gate on the platform. Ride personnel do not have the training required to physically load or unload Guests who need assistance. Guests needing assistance transferring from ECVs or wheelchairs must visit the Park with a companion. Our ride Team Members may provide information or answer questions. Only companions necessary to assist during the ride cycle should enter with the disabled Guest- maximum of (1) Guest due to the maximum number of riders per unit (2) for this ride. All other riders should enter at the entrance of the attraction. The disabled Guest and their party should be placed on the next available ride vehicle. Do not attempt to exit the ride until it has come to a complete stop and an attendant has instructed you it is safe to exit. Service animals are only permitted to accompany Guests while in the queue line. The service animal may not enter ride vehicles.

Blackfoot Falls



Minimum Height: 36" Anyone between 36" - 42" must ride with someone 16 years of age or older

Ride Time: 1 min 30 sec

This water ride takes a quick turn, to a sudden drop, plunging Guests into

the water below. YOU WILL GET WET! Each boat is equipped with lap bar restraints. All Guests are required to use all restraint systems on the ride. Those restraints must be able to be positioned properly. All Guests wearing casts or other restrictive devices may not be able to ride if it prohibits proper securing of the restraint device. The access entrance for Blackfoot Falls is at the exit gate. Guests may leave wheelchairs, carts, etc. . . near exit gate on the platform. Ride personnel do not have the training required to physically load or unload Guests who need assistance. Guests needing assistance transferring from ECVs or wheelchairs must visit the Park with a companion. Our ride Team Members may provide information or answer questions. Only companions necessary to assist during the ride cycle should enter with the disabled Guest- maximum of (3) Guest due to the maximum number of riders per unit (4) for this ride. All other riders should enter at the entrance of the attraction. The disabled Guest and their party should be placed on the next available ride vehicle. Please keep hands and feet inside at all times and remain seated. Do not attempt to exit the ride until it has come to a complete stop and an attendant has instructed you it is safe to exit. Service animals are only permitted to accompany Guests while in the queue line. The service animal may not enter ride vehicles.

Boomerang

Minimum Height: 48"

Ride Time: 1 min 45 sec



This thrill ride, with its vertical loops, six inversions and two hills is designed to take you on a 50 mph scream ride. The lift hill will pull the train backwards then watch out as it's released. The train will trek through a loop and a boomerang element before it travels up second hill coming to a halt high in the air. It will then run through the entire track in reverse. All Guests are required to meet minimum height and admission requirements, regardless of ability. Each ride unit is equipped with a Shoulder Harness Restraint. All Guests are required to use all restraints systems on the ride. Those restraints must be able to be positioned properly. All Guests wearing casts or other restrictive devices may not be able to ride if it prohibits proper securing of the restraint device. The access entrance for Boomerang is at the entrance gate. Guests must leave wheelchairs, carts, etc. to load the ride. These devices can be left outside the ride area near the entrance gates. Ride personnel do not have the training required to physically load or unload Guests who need assis-

tance. Guests needing assistance transferring from ECVs or wheelchairs must visit the Park with a companion. Our ride Team Members may provide information or answer questions. Only companions necessary to assist during the ride cycle should enter with the disabled Guest- maximum of (3) Guests due to the maximum number of riders per unit (4) for this ride. All other riders should enter the ride as other Guests. The disabled Guest and their party should be placed on the next available ride vehicle. Service animals only are permitted to accompany Guests while in the queue line. The service animal may not enter ride vehicles.

Bug Out



Minimum Height: 46" Guests between 46" and 50" must be accompanied by someone 16 years of age or older. Maximum height is 75"

Ride Time: 1 min 30 sec

The Bug Out roller coaster cars moves individually around the track. The first hill takes riders up 50 feet and it is all downhill from there as the track seemingly disappears on 180-degree turns. This coaster is a rush for riders with lots of aromatic hills and turns. Each car is equipped with lap bar restraints. All Guests are required to use all restraint systems on the ride. Those restraints must be able to be positioned properly. All Guests wearing casts or other restrictive devices may not be able to ride if it prohibits proper securing of the restraint device. The access entrance for Bug Out is at the exit gate. Guests may leave wheelchairs, carts, etc. . . outside of the Safety Critical Area in a safe location. Ride personnel do not have the training required to physically load or unload Guests who need assistance. Guests needing assistance transferring from ECVs or wheelchairs must visit the Park with a companion. Our ride Team Members may provide information or answer questions. Only companions necessary to assist during the ride cycle should enter with the disabled Guest- maximum of (3) Guest due to the maximum number of riders per unit (4) for this ride. All other riders should enter at the entrance of the attraction. The disabled Guest and their party should be placed on the next available ride vehicle. Please keep hands and feet inside at all times and remain seated. Do not attempt to exit the ride until it has come to a complete stop and an attendant has instructed you it is safe to exit. Service animals are only permitted to accompany Guests while in the queue line. The service animal may not enter ride vehicles.

Bugs of the Jungle

Ride Descriptions

Minimum Height: Between 32" - 42" only

Ride Time: 1 minute 45 sec



Guests riding this rotating "animal" round ride must have upper body control and the ability to sit up straight with the restraint fastened. A seat belt must be worn at all times. Due to the nature of this ride, Guests may need companion assistance transferring to a ride vehicle. Guests using wheelchairs, ECV's or those with other disabilities should wait at the ride exit gate for Team Member assistance.

Century Wheel

Minimum Height: Below 42" must ride with someone 16 years of age or older

Ride Time: 2 min 30 sec



This family favorite is a classic big wheel ride that is approximately 66 feet in the air and moves in a circular motion. Each ride unit is equipped with Gondola doors on both sides of the gondola. For your safety please do not rock the Gondola. All Guests wearing casts or other restrictive devices may not be able to ride if it prohibits proper securing of the restraint device. The access entrance for The Century Wheel is at the exit gate. Guests may leave wheelchairs, carts, etc. . . outside of the Safety Critical Area near the entrance of the ride or the exit. Ride personnel do not have the training required to physically load or unload Guests who need assistance. Guests needing assistance transferring from ECVs or wheelchairs must visit the Park with a companion. Our ride Team Members may provide information or answer questions. Only companions necessary to assist during the ride cycle should enter with the disabled Guest- maximum of (3) Guest due to the maximum number of riders per unit (4) for this ride. All other riders should enter at the entrance of the attraction. The disabled Guest and their party should be placed on the next available ride vehicle. Please keep hands and feet inside at all times and remain seated. Do not attempt to exit the ride until it has come to a complete stop and an attendant has instructed you it is safe to exit. Service animals are only permitted to accompany Guests while in the queue line. The service animal may not enter ride vehicles.

Cheetah

Minimum Height: 48"

Ride Time: 1 minute 40 sec

Experience the thrill of our wooden roller-

coaster! At 90 feet tall and 3000 feet long, the

trains hit speeds of 50mph and combines doses of zero gravity time, high lifts and dramatic drops with a figure eight ending all combine to create a memory worth repeating! All Guests are required to meet minimum height and admission requirements, regardless of ability. Each ride unit is equipped with a Lap Bar. Please keep seat belts buckled at all times. All Guests are required to use all restraints systems on the ride. Those restraints must be able to be positioned properly. All Guests wearing casts or other restrictive devices may not be able to ride if it prohibits proper securing of the restraint device. The access entrance for Cheetah is the exit. Guests must leave wheelchairs, carts, etc. to load the ride. These devices can be left outside in the station. Ride personnel do not have the training required to physically load or unload Guests who need assistance. Guests needing assistance transferring from ECVs or wheelchairs must visit the Park with a companion. Our ride Team Members may provide information or answer questions. Only companions necessary to assist during the ride cycle should enter with the disabled Guest-maximum of (3) Guests due to the maximum number of riders per unit (4) for this ride. All other riders should enter the ride as other Guests. The disabled Guest and their party should be placed on the next available ride vehicle. Service animals only are permitted to accompany Guests while in the queue line. The service animal may not enter ride vehicles.



Crazy Bus

Minimum Height: Between 32" and 36" must ride with an adult

Ride Time: 1 minute 30 seconds

At 10mph, this children's thrill ride is con-

stantly rotating; creating clockwise and counterclockwise wave effects. Each unit is equipped with a locking lap bar and a gate door. All guests are required to use all restraints systems on the ride. Those restraints must be positioned properly. All Guests wearing casts or other restrictive devices may not be able to ride if it prohibits proper securing of the restraint device. The access entrance for The Crazy Bus is at the exit gate. Guests may leave wheelchairs, carts, etc. . . outside of the Safety Critical Area in a safe location near the entrance of the ride or the exit. Ride personnel do not have the training required to physically load or unload Guests who need assistance. Guests needing assistance transfer-

ring from ECVs or wheelchairs must visit the Park with a companion. Our ride Team Members may provide information or answer questions. Only companions necessary to assist during the ride cycle should enter with the disabled Guest- maximum of (3) Guest due to the maximum number of riders per unit (4) for this ride. All other riders should enter at the entrance of the attraction. The disabled Guest and their companion should be placed on the next available ride vehicle. Please keep hands and feet inside at all times and remain seated. Do not attempt to exit the ride until it has come to a complete stop and an attendant has instructed you it is safe to exit. Service animals are only permitted to accompany Guests while in the queue line. The service animal may not enter ride vehicles.

Critter Crawl

Minimum Height: Must be below 50"

Ride Time: NA

Interactive children's play area where children can climb and slide on "jungle-themed" play structure. Ground level of this walk-through playground is wheel chair accessible.



Crop Duster

Minimum Height: Anyone below 36" must be accompanied by someone 16 years of age or older

Ride Time: 1 min 45 sec

The Crop Duster is a family ride that consists of six airplanes that can be individually navigated for "lift-off," at 4 rpm. Due to the nature of this ride, all guests must have upper body strength. Each unit is equipped with Safety Belt Restraints. Please keep Seat Belts buckled at all times. All Guests are required to use all restraint systems on the ride. Those restraints must be able to be positioned properly. All Guests wearing casts or other restrictive devices may not be able to ride if it prohibits proper securing of the restraint device. The access entrance for Crop Duster is at the exit gate. Guests may leave wheelchairs, carts, etc. . . near exit gate on platform. Ride personnel do not have the training required to physically load or unload Guests who need assistance. Guests needing assistance transferring from ECVs or wheelchairs must visit the Park with a companion. Our ride Team Members may provide informa-

Guests needing assistance transferring from ECVs or wheelchairs must visit the Park with a companion. Team Members may provide information or answer questions. Only companions necessary to assist during the ride cycle should enter with the disabled Guest- maximum of (1) Guest. All other riders should enter the ride as other Guests. The disabled Guest and their party should be placed on the next available ride vehicle. Service animals only are permitted to accompany Guests while in the queue line. The service animal may not enter ride vehicles.

Tasmanian River Rapids



Minimum Height: 36" Anyone between 36"- 48" must be accompanied by someone 16 years of age or older
Ride Time: 8 minutes

This ride takes the rider twisting and turning through white water type rapids. YOU MAY GET WET! All Guests are required to meet minimum height and admission requirements, regardless of ability. This Attraction is not equipped with a Passenger Restraint System. The access entrance for Tasmanian River Rapids is at the exit gate. Guests must leave wheelchairs, carts, etc. to load the ride. These devices can be left outside of the Safety Critical Area in a safe location. Ride personnel do not have the training required to physically load or unload Guests who need assistance. Guests needing assistance transferring from ECVs or wheelchairs must visit the Park with a companion. Our ride Team Members may provide information or answer questions. Only companions necessary to assist during the ride cycle should enter with the disabled Guest- maximum of (2) Guests due to the maximum number of riders per unit (3) for this ride. All other riders should enter the ride as other Guests. The disabled Guest and their party should be placed on the next available ride vehicle. Service animals only are permitted to accompany Guests while in the queue line. The service animal may not enter ride vehicles.

Tilt-A-Weevil



Minimum Height: 32" Guests between 32"- 46" must be accompanied by someone 16 years of age or older
Ride Time: 1 min 30 sec

This is a family ride, which has been entertaining families for generations. The first Tilt-a-Weevil was designed over 75 years ago. The

brightly colored cars tip and turn on fixed pivot pins as the revolving platform rollover mild hills and valleys. All Guests are required to meet minimum height and admission requirements, regardless of ability. Each ride unit is equipped with a Non-Locking Lap bar Restraint. All Guests are required to use all restraints systems on the ride. Those restraints must be able to be positioned properly. All Guests wearing casts or other restrictive devices may not be able to ride if it prohibits proper securing of the restraint device. The access entrance for Tilt-A-Weevil is at the entrance gate. Guests must leave wheelchairs, carts, be able to make it up the steps, etc. to load the ride. These devices can be left outside of the Safety Critical Area in a safe location. Ride personnel do not have the training required to physically load or unload Guests who need assistance. Guests needing assistance transferring from ECVs or wheelchairs must visit the Park with a companion. Our ride Team Members may provide information or answer questions; however, they are not trained to assist Guests in transferring to and from a ride vehicle and will not be able to do so. Only companions necessary to assist during the ride cycle should enter with the disabled Guest- maximum of (3) Guests. All other riders should enter the ride as other Guests. The disabled Guest and their party should be placed on the next available ride vehicle. Service animals only are permitted to accompany Guests while in the queue line. The service animal may not enter ride vehicles.

Turtle Race

Minimum Height: Must be between 36"-
46" to ride



Ride Time: 1 minute 30 sec

The Turtle Race is a circular children's ride that consists of eight extended arms that glide in an up and down motion. All Guests are required to meet minimum height and admission requirements, regardless of ability. Each ride unit is equipped with a Seat Belt Restraint. Please keep seat belts buckled at all times. All Guests are required to use all restraints systems on the ride. Those restraints must be able to be positioned properly. All Guests wearing casts or other restrictive devices may not be able to ride if it prohibits proper securing of the restraint device. The access entrance for the Turtle Race is the entrance. Guests must leave wheelchairs, carts, etc. to load the ride. These devices can be left outside of the Safety Critical Area in a safe location. Ride personnel do not have the training required to physically load or unload Guests who need assis-

tance. Guests needing assistance transferring from ECVs or wheelchairs must visit the Park with a companion. Our ride Team Members may provide information or answer questions. Only companions necessary to assist during the ride cycle should enter with the disabled Guest- maximum of (3) Guests due to the maximum number of riders per unit (4) for this ride. All other riders should enter the ride as other Guests. The disabled Guest and their party should be placed on the next available ride vehicle. Venus Fly Trap



Minimum Height: 44" Anyone between 44" - 48" must be accompanied by someone 16 years of age or older

Ride Time: 2 min

The Venus flytrap is a family thrill ride which lifts and rotates riders. In addition, riders can spin their own individual ride unit. All Guests are required to meet minimum height and admission requirements, regardless of ability. Each ride unit is equipped with a Lap Bar Restraint. All Guests are required to use all restraints systems on the ride. Those restraints must be able to be positioned properly. All Guests wearing casts or other restrictive devices may not be able to ride if it prohibits proper securing of the restraint device. The access entrance for Venus flytrap is at the entrance gate. Guests must leave wheelchairs, carts, etc. to load the ride. These devices can be left outside of the Safety Critical Area in a safe location. Ride personnel do not have the training required to physically load or unload Guests who need assistance. Guests needing assistance transferring from ECVs or wheelchairs must visit the Park with a companion. Our ride Team Members may provide information or answer questions. Only companions necessary to assist during the ride cycle should enter with the disabled Guest- maximum of (3) Guests due to the maximum number of riders per unit (4) for this ride. All other riders should enter the ride as other Guests. The disabled Guest and their party should be placed on the next available ride vehicle. Service animals only are permitted to accompany Guests while in the queue line. The service animal may not enter ride vehicles.

Wee Wagons



Minimum Height: Anyone below 36" must be accompanied by someone 16 years of age or older

The Wee Wagons is a children's locomotive which takes them on a winding track. All Guests are required to meet minimum height and admission requirements, regardless of ability. Due to the nature of this ride, all guests must have upper body strength. Each ride unit is equipped with a Seat Belt Buckle. Please keep seat belts buckled at all times. All Guests are required to use all restraints systems on the ride. Those restraints must be able to be positioned properly. All Guests wearing casts or other restrictive devices may not be able to ride if it prohibits proper securing of the restraint device. The access entrance for the Wee Wagons is at the exit gate. Guests must leave wheelchairs, carts, etc. to enter the ride area. Ride personnel do not have the training required to physically load or unload Guests who need assistance. Guests needing assistance transferring from an ECV or wheelchair must visit the Park with a companion. Our ride Team Members may provide information or answer questions; however, they are not trained to assist you in transferring to and from a ride vehicle and will not be able to do so. Only companions necessary to assist during the ride cycle should enter with the disabled Guest- maximum of (3) Guests due to the maximum number of riders per unit (4) for this ride. All other riders should enter the ride as other Guests. The disabled Guest and their party should be placed on the next available ride vehicle. Service animals only are permitted to accompany Guests while in the queue line. The service animal may not enter ride vehicles.

Yo-Yo

Minimum Height: 42"

Ride Time: 2 min 30 sec



The Yo-Yo is an outdoor ride located in the Wild West area. It is important to remember that the following specifications set by the manufacturer. Each ride unit is equipped with a Lap Bar Restraint. All Guests are required to meet minimum height and admission requirements, regardless of ability. All Guests are required to use all restraints systems on the ride. Those restraints must be able to be positioned properly. All Guests wearing casts or other restrictive devices may not be able to ride if it prohibits proper securing of the restraint device. The access entrance for YO-YO is at the entrance gate. Guests must leave wheelchairs, carts, etc. to load the ride. These devices can be left outside of the Safety Critical Area in a safe location. Ride personnel do not have the training required to physically load or unload Guests who need assistance. Guests

needing assistance transferring from ECVs or wheelchairs must visit the Park with a companion. Our ride Team Members may provide information or answer questions. Only companions necessary to assist during the ride cycle should enter with the disabled Guest- maximum of (3) Guests due to the maximum number of riders per unit (4) for this ride. All other riders should enter the ride as other Guests. The disabled Guest and their party should be placed on the next available ride vehicle. Service animals only are permitted to accompany Guests while in the queue line. The service animal may not enter ride vehicles.

Arrival & Departure

Disability Parking

The main parking area and van accessible spaces for Guests with disabilities are located in the disability parking area adjacent to the Park entrance. Upon arrival at Wild Adventures please advise the Toll Booth Team Members that you need disability parking, and they will direct you to the disability lot or the Guest Drop Off & Pickup Area. Disabled parking is filled on a first-come, first-served basis and may reach capacity early on some days. If the disability parking area is unavailable, the Guest Drop Off & Pickup Area adjacent to the Park entrance may be utilized for ease of dropping off and picking up Guests with disabilities. Standard vehicle and RV parking fees apply unless Guest is a Wild Adventures Gold or Super Gold Passholder.

All vehicles parked in a marked disabled parking space must have a government-issued license plate or displayed disabled parking tag. Without proper permits, violators may be subject to fines issued by the Lowndes County Sheriff's Department and/or towing of the vehicle at the owner's expense.

Guest Drop Off & Pickup Area

For our Guests' convenience, we provide a Guest Drop Off & Pickup Area located at the Park's front gate entrance. Instead of boarding a tram, Guests using wheelchairs as well as those using ECVs may use this location to access or leave the Park.

Service animals are allowed on trams as long as they meet guidelines outlined in the Service Animals section of this brochure.
